Historically, the JIASE has been abstracted in Bioabstracts, State Academies of Science Abstracts (SASA), U.S. Department of the Interior Fish and Wildlife Service Publications, Wildlife Review and Sport Fisheries Abstracts, and deposited in over 40 libraries, nationally and internationally.
